



JCPB Tree-Line Maintenance Agreement

The American National Standards Institute (ANSI) requires a minimum of 10 feet of clearance surrounding overhead power distribution lines and allows up to 50 feet of clearance surrounding overhead power transmission lines. This safety zone is intended to prevent power line and tree conflicts which are costly, dangerous and cause power outages.

As a customer of the JCPB, I understand that:

- Trees must be planted a safe distance from power lines.
- Large tree varieties require the greatest distance from power lines (25' min. recommended).
- If a tree is planted underneath or is growing into the ANSI mandated safety zone surrounding any JCPB power lines, said tree will be trimmed or removed as necessary and without compensation to the owner.
